Our mission here at Drop the H Brewing Company is to provide you with “Craft Beer, Craft Pizza” and a “Craft Experience.” Part and parcel of that experience is an environment that is more than simply welcoming—it is one that is safe, both for our team members and our guests.

As such, we have always made food safety and the cleanliness of our facility priority number one. This hasn't changed. What has changed, given concerns over the coronavirus, is that we've revamped our processes to go above and beyond our already high standards. The next time you visit, you will notice that we're enhancing the sanitization of public areas. For example, when you first walk in, you'll note that we have two hand-sanitizing stations, one at either end of the bar. You'll also see small hand-sanitizer bottles at each table. When tables are cleaned, we clean not just the tabletop. We clean the salt & pepper shakers, and the beer menus, etc. At the end of your visit, you'll note too that our point of sale device is cleaned before it is offered to you to handle. In short, we have ensured that every possible, prudent precaution is being taken.

Day-to-day, our team members know that they are never to come to work sick. This also remains the case. Again, given current concerns, we've strengthened that guidance. We've checked—none of our team members have been to any CDC Level 3 Travel Health Notice country nor are they symptomatic, nor have they been in contact with anyone who was or is.

For your part, should you decide to travel to a Level 3 Travel Health Notice country, we kindly ask you respect your fellow patrons and refrain from visiting for the 14 days recommended by the CDC. The same holds true if you have been in contact with anyone who has been to any of those places or if they/you are symptomatic.

We believe that, should we all practice good hygiene and be respectful of others, we'll get through this—all while enjoying ourselves and the company of others.
